THE ENHANCE PROJECT IS HALF WAY THROUGH

Dear ENHANCE members.

This newsletter is an overview of the first half period of the ENHANCE project, reviewing the activities carried out, the newest events in the last six months and the activities that are scheduled until the end of 2017.

The first one and a half year of "Building an Excellency Network for Heightening Agricultural ecoNomic researCh and Education in Romania" (ENHANCE) project was strewn with important activities and results, on the way to fulfill its most important objectives: three training sessions scheduled for year 2016 and three for the first six months of 2017, the first Summer School at USAMV, eight completed and three ongoing staff exchanges, all these having a great scientific impact on the beneficiaries.

The following results have been achieved:

Training sessions



In the last six months, three more training sessions were organized and completed at USAMV, in order to refresh and increase the qualification of USAMV staff and PhD students in economic theories and methods.

In general, the courses consisted of lectures, exercises, home reading and group work.

At the end of each course, all participants received a Certificate of Attendance.

In total, six training sessions out of twelve were conducted by the three international project partners, i.e. BOKU, AGROSCOPE and IAMO, respectively. BOKU focuses on "qualitative and quantitative research design", AGROSCOPE on "econometrics" and IAMO on "economic modelling and simulation methods".

These training sessions complement individual, bi- and multilateral research in the framework of the staff exchange and mentorship activities.

Staff exchanges

The main objective of the staff exchanges was to implement a bilateral interaction on scientific and professional issues between the USAMV beneficiaries and host partners and the partners' beneficiaries and USAMV's hosts. From these experiences all the persons involved had important results and benefited from the foreign infusion of knowledge.

Departing from USAMV in the **year 2016**, three staff exchanges were organized: two departures were hosted by the Leibniz Institute of Agricultural Development in Transition Economies from Germany (IAMO) - **Mr. Dragoş Smedescu**, Ph.D., Lecturer at FMIEADR and **Ms. Armeniţa Arghiroiu**, also a Ph.D., Lecturer at FMIEADR and one to Austria, at the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences - **Ms. Stelica Cristea**, Ph.D., Professor, Director of IRMVA Doctoral School.

In the first six months of the **year 2017**, two more departures were carried out.




Ms. Raluca Necula, Ph.D., Lecturer at FMIEADR (3 January 2017 – 2 April

The staff exchanges having as host USAMV were all from AGROSCOPE, the Federal Research Centre for Agriculture from Tänikon, Switzerland and were organized as follows:

- > Two in the first six months of year 2017
 - Ms. Alena Schmidt, PhD. Student (23 January 2017 23 March 2017), hosted by three lecturers from FMIEADR, Mr. Petrică Ştefan, Mrs. Cristina Buzatu and Mr. Dragoş Smedescu, studying together issues related with the environmental sciences.
 - Mrs. Gabriele Mack, Researcher (4 April 2017 4 June 2017) who had as main research topic an evaluation of the direct payments in Romania, collaborating with Mrs. Gina Fîntîneru, Ph.D., Professor at FMIEADR.



Ongoing staff exchanges of FMIEADR staff to partner institutions

At present three more staff exchanges are ongoing, with a very broad field of research:

- ➤ Mr. Petrică Ştefan (3 May 2017 31 July 2017), is currently studying the wine tourism in the Federal Research Centre for Agriculture (AGROSCOPE) from Tänikon, Switzerland together with Dr. Ştefan Mann.
- ➤ Also at AGROSCOPE is hosted Mrs. Gina Fîntîneru (19 June 2017 6 August 2017) continuing the research started in Romania with Mrs. Gabriele Mack on the impact of direct payments on the attractiveness and vitality of rural areas.
- ➤ A research stay in another host partner (IAMO) is now developed by Mrs. Ionela Mituko Vlad (11 June 2017 8 September 2017), studying the evolution of the structure of farm population in Romania, the impact on labour use, EU project SURE- Farm and demographic issues of Romanian Agriculture, with the important help of Dr. Ilkay Unay Gailhard and Dr. Alfons Balmann.

The summer school


- ➤ Last year in September the first Summer School of this project, USAMV Bucharest Agricultural Economics and Policy took place in Bucharest, focusing on "Scientific Working", with lecturers from the University of Natural Resources and Life Sciences (BOKU), Vienna, Austria. It was a first experience of the USAMV organizers with a Summer School event, the results and feedback of the participants being more than overwhelming, encouraging the preparations for the next Summer School at USAMV that will take place in September, 2017.
- ➤ The second ENHANCE Summer School (18-22 September 2017) will focus on "Policy Evaluation in Agriculture" and the subjects will range from the normative foundations of policy evaluation over methodological tasks to public policy as the object of evaluation. The course tutors will be Dr. Stefan Mann from The Federal Department of Economics, Education and Research (AGROSCOPE) and Dr. Matthias Stolze from The Research Institute for Organic Agriculture (FIBL), both Switzerland, two lecturers with impressive experience in teaching and applying policy evaluation.

The best participants were selected by a commission of academic and scientific experts from the Consortium institutions, the selection criteria including:

- Education in fields related to agricultural economics and policy.
- Previous experience and knowledge in the agro-economics and policy field.
- Geographic balance.
- Gender balance.


Dissemination activities
