The event, which took place in Poiana Braşov, brought together 450 of the most influential farmers and processors in the food industry. The central theme of the congress was "Common Agricultural Policy (CAP) 2021-2027", given that during the European Union's presidency of the European Union, the CAP is the most important dossier Romania will manage from the point of view of agricultural sector. Romania is part of the 6 largest EU countries in terms of agricultural area - 13.9 million hectares.
